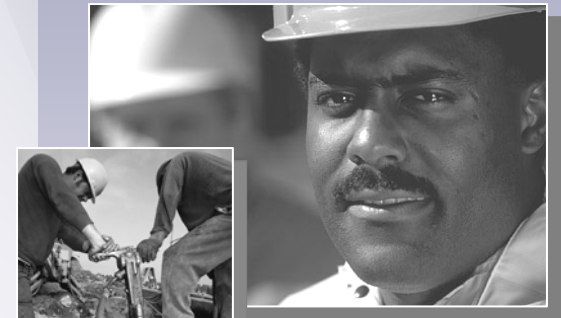

Safety Consulting Services

Many general contractors are now requiring OSHA 10 or 30 Hour training certifications for their subcontractors employees or foreman. They're also looking more closely at contractor's safety records and policies to determine if the contractor is a liability risk.

Job Site Evaluations:

Complete site hazard assessments that identify hazardous conditions, OSHA violations for both the client and their on-site subcontractors are provided. Job site evaluations also include 5-10 minute training sessions (toolbox talks) for job site employees.

Job Site Evaluation Reports:

Job site visit reports will include color photographs and a written explanation of the hazard or OSHA violation seen during the site visit. Reports will also include an overall summary of the site and comments regarding subcontractor activities. Below is an example of a typical OSHA violation write-up.

OSHA 10 & 30 Hour Construction Training:

OSHA 10 & 30 Hour certificates are often required by general contractors. This class is offered by our staff.. Prior to the session, our staff can meet with site management to clarify work being performed, common industry hazards, and the jobs specific needs so that the class is tailored to the operation.

Employee Training:

OSHA requires that employee be informed of the hazards associated with their work environment. Cambridge can develop and present interactive training sessions using visual aids to help assist employee retention on the important information within each presentation.

Industrial Hygiene Sampling:

Cambridge has the expertise and equipment to perform industrial hygeine sampling. Air quality and sound level testing can be completed in any area or on a specific job.

Formal Visit & Industrial Hygeine Reports:

Formal reports will list the services performed during the visit, and an action plan for next service visit. Industrial Hygiene (IH) reports will list the conditions, areas and results of the testing performed .

Typical Observation

from a sample jobsite report:

"OSHA Violation: Each end of a platform, unless cleated or otherwise restrained by hooks or equivalent means, shall extend over the centerline of its support at least 6 inches (15 cm)."
