The BLS also indicates that in 2001 34% of all non-fatal occupational injuries and illnesses that involved days away from work were MSDs (musculoskeletal disorders) – that's over 520,000 ergonomic injuries!

In addition, the US Chamber of Commerce reported in January of 2001 that these injuries often require corrective surgery, may be permanently disabling, and cost employers between \$15 and \$20 billion per year in workers' compensation costs.
